


DSA has been named a John Irwin School of Excellence by CDE for past decade.



Named one of the Top High Schools in America by US News and World Report and a Gold Medal Winner for nine years








ACT Junior Composite Exam scores is 27




SAT Composite Score is 1270

Middle school academics are located on the main floor and high school academics on the second floor


Students have daily arts instruction of 95 minutes per day

DSA doesn't offer PE/Athletics- we have no athletic facilities in our building.






DSA Math Sequence and Graphic




Students are accelerated in 8th grade and have the opportunity to take AP Calculus B/C









11 arts majors produce over 120 performances, showcases, and exhibits during the school year.


Student travel is an important component of the arts program.

Stagecraft & Design is the only arts majors that begin accepting students in the 9th grade only.










Currently 8th grade students have an exploratory wheel that introduces student to arts forms other than their major.

Multiple activities and clubs exist at DSA.




Students are able to participate in athletics through their home school program or George Washington High School in DPS at the high school level, and their home middle school or DSST middle school.



DSA has a national award winning National History Day program and Destination Imagination Program.

Services for students with disabilities and gifted and talented students are provided at DSA.





Students who reside outside the City of Denver, and current high school students can apply for an exception to ride a yellow bus, if there is room on a particular bus.


High school students who reside in Denver and live outside the three mile walk zone will receive an RTD bus pass.

Parents are asked to volunteer within their departments each school year.

The DSA Friends Foundation hosts an annual fundraising Gala in the fall and raises money through our annual Fill the Gap Campaign for the Visiting and Guest Artist and Scholar Program, a student support fund, and the DSA Summer of Arts (a program for underserved students who have limited access to the arts education).









Each year the DSA Friends Foundation Sponsors an annual fundraising campaign called the *Fill the Gap*. This campaign is designed to fill the gap between state funding and the costs associated with educating a students in a high-quality preprofessional arts program. The current gap is \$1,320.00 per student. We ask all of our families to contribute on a level that supports their budget.



Our goal is that 100% of DSA families participate in this fundraising program.







The DSA Visiting Artist and Scholars program brings in over 200 artists each year to work with our students in their majors and academic courses. The majority of these artists are part of the Denver arts community and active artists in our community. These artists are funded through the *Fill the Gap* campaign.






Pre-audition meetings take place the week of January 7th.

Auditions take place in February at pre-assigned audition times, assigned at the pre-audition meeting.

You must complete both the on line application and attend the pre-audition meeting in order to be assigned a February audition time.

You must complete the district School of Choice form.



Emails regarding qualified, wait list, and not qualified are sent on Tuesday, February 26, 2019.

Students may select to audition for a different major during their tenure at DSA. Students apply online, attend the pre-audition meeting, and complete an audition for the new major. If they are successful with their audition they move to the new major. If they are not successful in the audition they remain in their current major without giving up their spot at DSA.
