This is reminder that the school office, the building and district offices will be closed for the Thanksgiving Holiday from Wednesday, November 23rd through Sunday, November 27th.

Start planning ahead for the final week of first semester for DSA students. Students will be taking final assessments and completing end of semester work on Wednesday, December 14th and Thursday 15th. For 8- 12th grade students, Wednesday exams will be periods 1,3,5,7 and Thursdays exams will be 2,4,6,8. DSA 6th and 7th grade students will attend classes on their regular schedule both days. There will be **no** classes for DSA students on Friday, December 16th and DPS Transportation will not run regular routes. Students who have make up work to complete will be notified by their teachers if they need to report to DSA on Friday, December 16th.

Pre-audition meetings begin the week of November 28th. If your student has applied to change their major make sure you refer to the DSA calendar and attend this required meeting in order to audition in January.
