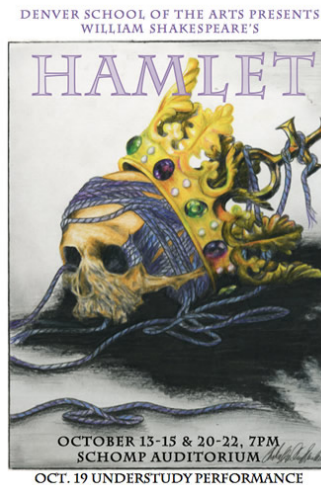

Bring your Kiddos to the Next DSA "Play" Date While You Enjoy HAMLET.

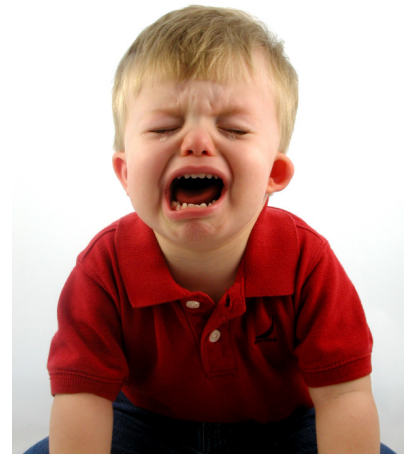
