Dear DSA Families,

I want to notify you that the district has reassigned our Social Worker and Psychologist to other positions within the Denver Public Schools. Beginning on Monday, October 15, 2018 we will have temporary support personnel assigned to DSA on a rotating basis until permanent replacements are hired by the district and placed at DSA. Until permanent replacements are assigned to DSA these temporary providers will be working out of room 106L in the main office.

For your information, all Specialized Service Providers (Social Workers, Psychologists, and Nurses) are hired by the district and managed by the District Department of Social Work, Psych Services, and Nursing Services. These departments assigns these providers to schools.

I ask that you talk with your student and let them know that if an emergency situation arises they should report to the main office.
