Do you love to sing? Want to learn how to find your true voice, or reach the next level in your singing? FAQ'S

What does rising 5th grade mean?

If your child with be a 5^{th} grader during the 2020-2021 school year they are considered a rising 5^{th} grader. So, in essence we are asking what grade your child will be in next year.
