

DSA Grades 8-12 Schedule for Live Remote Learning

Overview:

- Each day, students can access content-area instruction following their semester 2 schedule. Each remote class period is scheduled for 45 minutes and will be reserved for live/recorded* teacher content and work time for students.
- If the teacher chooses to host a live class, they will record it and provide students access to it via a link on their [main Google document](#). This is in the event that the student is not able to attend the live class but still needs to review the content.
- Teachers can determine if they want to assign additional work to be completed outside of the 45-minute class period.
- Since the week of April 6th is a four day school week, we will revert to Black/White/Black/White.

Time will be determined and communicated to students by the teacher. → Other content (accommodations support, academic counseling, mental health support, for example) may take place during this time. → Students use this time to complete assignments from earlier in the day. 		

*Please note: each teacher has the ability to determine how the 45-minute class period will be used. For example: Monday's classes may include a 30-minute live Google Meet, while the Wednesday class has just a 5-minute recorded message from the teacher. Students must access their teacher's [main Google document](#) to learn how the teacher is structuring their allotted time. ***What is consistent is that teachers may only use their allotted time for delivery of live classes (to ensure that live classes by different teachers are not overlapping).***
